

Introduction:

1. Any offence against the dictates of common sense or good manners is a breach of school rules.

Behaviour outside School:

2. Noisy, disorderly conduct or any kind in street, train, bus or public building will be treated as a school offence.
3. On the way to and from School boys must not walk more than two abreast.
4. Boys cycling down Abercrombie Street must walk their cycles from the last street lamp on the left hand side and across the road, and boys cycling from the town along Sheffield Road to dismount before crossing the road.
5. No boys permitted to cycle on the School premises.
6. All boys below the Transitus forms must wear caps coming to School and returning from School and also when travelling with School parties.
7. Boys may not enter the School through the Technical College grounds.

Behaviour at School:

8. No boy may enter a form room other than his own without definite instructions from a Master.
9. Between periods, unless there is a change of room, no boy may leave his seat or the room without a Master's permission. Quiet talking is permitted but nothing beyond this.
10. Loitering in cloakrooms or lavatories is strictly forbidden.
11. Running in the school buildings is forbidden.
12. Boys must not remain in the school buildings after 4 p.m. unless they have some legitimate business approved by a Master.
13. Defacement of school or private property will be regarded as a serious offence.
14. All personal property must be clearly marked with the owner's name.
15. No money or valuables should be left in desks or in the cloakrooms.
16. If a boy feels ill during the school day he must not go home without permission from the Headmaster or the Second master.
17. Homework is not to be done in school.
18. No boy may borrow or in any way interfere with the private property of another boy.
19. Boys are forbidden to barter or have money transactions with one another.
20. No boy may bring into the school premises any catapult, firearm or toy pistol, ammunition for these, or fireworks.
21. Any action in defiance of the properly exercised authority of prefect is regarded as an offence against the authority of the Headmaster.
22. No boy is allowed to smoke on the school premises or in public whilst he is a member of the School.
23. No boy may bring playing cards to School.

Bounds:

24. The following places are out of bounds:-
  - (a) Fire escape except in emergency.
  - (b) The path and garden in front of the Headmaster's study.
  - (c) All land between the fives court, the huts and the St. Helena School. (the only exception is the cycle path which may be used by boys leaving or taking their cycles).
  - (d) Air Raid Shelters,
  - (e) Behind the North Wing.
25. Only organised games are permitted on the lower field.

DINNERS:

Boys who have dinner at School will not be permitted to leave the premises during the dinner hour unless a written request has been received from their parents.

BREAK

(a) Fine:
