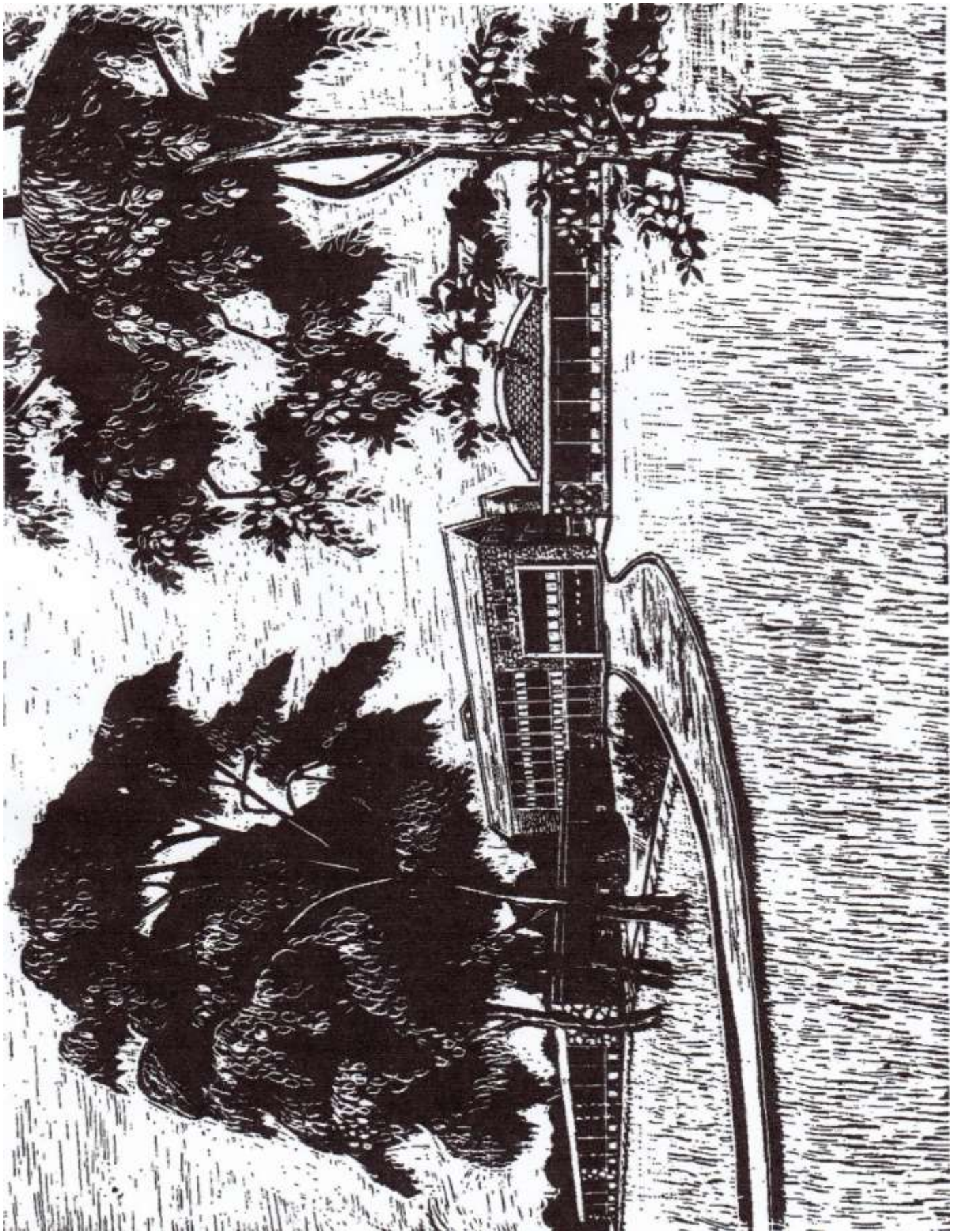

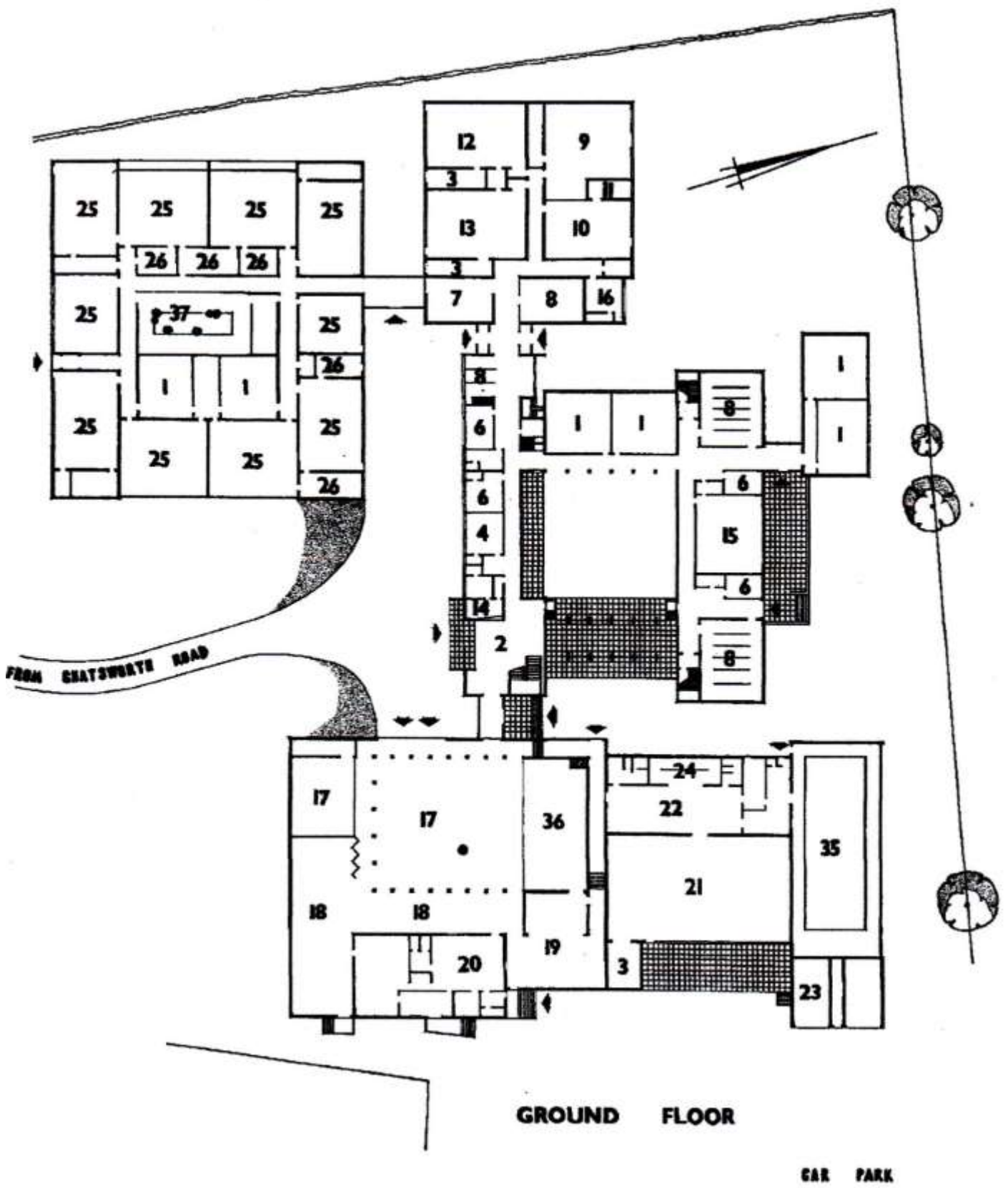

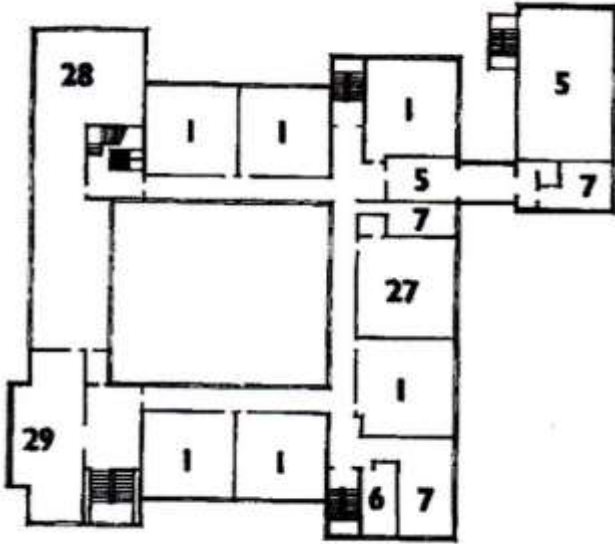
PROGRAMME

8. National Anthem.

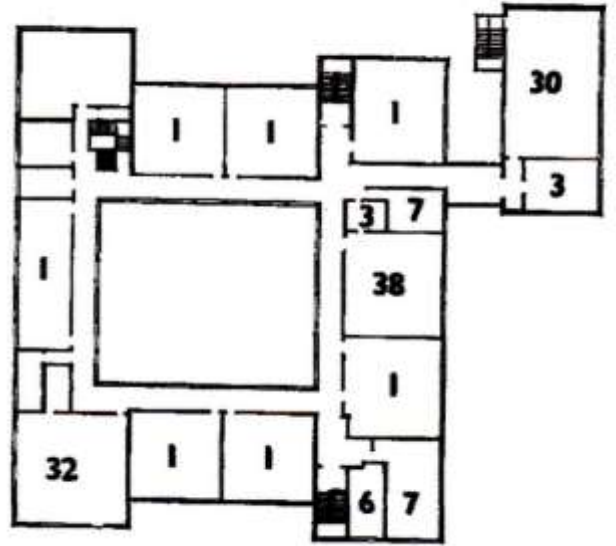
At the conclusion of the ceremony visitors are invited to look round the new building.
