## SCHEDULE 2

### OLD CESTREFELDIANS' TRUST

Items delivered to Tom Roberts for the Trust by Rob Wadd 31.7.18 ex Mr. David Howes, retired Chesterfield Barber and collector of old photos of Chesterfield. They are the part of the collection of trophies rescued by Maldwyn Hughes (Teacher and O.C.) from Brookfield School when "old junk" was being chucked out from under the stage into a skip. This batch of trophies were professionally valued as having nil value (as opposed to the other trophies rescued at the same time by Maldwyn and passed to the Trust earlier - which are silver). They were kept for a while by Mike Hadfield and then passed to Howes who kept them in his garage.

None of these trophies are solid silver – nearly all are silver plate but the silver coating is largely gone.

1. **Frank Merifield Trophy** A shield for House football competition presented by Old Cestrefeldians' Football Club Nov. 1964 with winners engraved from 1965/6 to 1974/5 and again in 1980/81.
2. **Chesterfield School Robert Birley Shield for Sailing** A shield for House competition with winners engraved from 1967 to 1975.
3. **Chesterfield School Inter House Association Football Under 13 Shield** . Winners engraved from 1930/31 to 1974/75
4. **Day Cup for Academic Achievement.** This large but very poor quality trophy is inscribed with a long list of Offices and titles held by Alderman H.C. Day, which unfortunately gives it the appearance of mainly being a boastful project by Ald. H.C. Day.  
It is not inscribed with any winners - maybe because it is such thin metal that engraving couldn't be done, or maybe Mr. Glistler just tucked it away somewhere and never awarded it?
5. **Chesterfield Grammar School Under 15 Association Football Inter House Competition Cup**  
Winners engraved from 1926/7 to 1985/6
6. **Chesterfield Grammar School Under 15 Cricket Cup** Winners engraved from 1926 to 1982
7. **All Ages Cricket House Championship Cup** Winners engraved from 1922 to 1975
8. **Chesterfield School House Relay Race Cup** (Swimming). Winners engraved from 1923 to 1983
9. **S.N.P.F. Concours Special 1951 Chesterfield School** and the same thing dated **1955**. These are small cups which appear to be the retained versions of a trophy or competition won by the School.
10. **One Mile Cup** (EPNS... very small).
